A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SUNSET ESTATES.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 215 of the Rural Municipality Act, no person shall use or discharge a firearm, including but not limited to a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun; air gun, spring gun, or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, rocks, or any other thing, within the limits of the Sunset Estates Mobile Home Park situated on property legally described as LSD 11, 14 32-36-3 W3 in the Rural Municipality of Blucher, No. 343, in the Province of Saskatchewan.
- 2. Section 1 shall not apply to any person having authority under a Statue of Canada or the Province of Saskatchewan to have in his possession a firearm, and the discharge thereof is within the scope of his duty, authority or occupation.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
