

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF
BLUCHER, NO. 343 TO COMPEL THE REMOVAL
OF DIRT, STONES, FILTH OR RUBBISH FROM
PUBLIC PLACES.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) Any person depositing any dirt, stones, filth, rubbish or any other encumbrance on any road, road allowance, land acquired for the widening of or diversion from a road allowance, lane or other public place within the municipality shall remove the same and place it where directed by the council within twenty-four hours after being ordered to do so by the council:
- 2) Bylaw No. 2-64 enacted on the 7th day of September, 1964, is hereby repealed.
