**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLUCHER, NO.
343 TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

Pursuant to Section 206 (2) of the Rural Municipality Act the Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher #343 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows

1. In this bylaw the expression
 - a) “public highway” shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highways and Transportation Act:
 - b) “ motor vehicle “ shall have the meaning ascribed to it by the Highways and Transportation Act
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 50 kilometres per hour on that portion of a public highway described as:
 3. WSW of Section 15-35-3 W3
 4. Thru SE 16 35-3 W3
 5. Thru NE 18-35-3 W3
 6. West of Section 30, 31-36-2-W3
 7. Thru Section 15-36-3 W3
8. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
9. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
10. That Bylaw 19-2001 be hereby repealed.
