

BYLAW 4-2004

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLUCHER, NO.
343 TO AMEND BYLAW 6-2002 BEING A BYLAW
CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw 6-2002 is amended as hereinafter set forth:

1. Insert the following section:

2.a) Signs containing the word "stop" shall be erected at the intersection of roadways and railway crossings at the following locations:

<u>Location of Intersection</u>	<u>Side of Road</u>	<u>Direction from Intersection</u>	<u>Facing Traffic From</u>
1. NW 2-35-3 W3	West	North	North
2. NW 2-35-3 W3	East	South	South
3. SE 2-35-3 W3	North	East	East
4. SE 2-35-3 W3	South	West	West
5. NW 17-35-3 W3	West	North	North
6. NW 17-35-3 W3	East	South	South
