**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLUCHER,
NO. 343 TO AMEND BYLAW 4-2001, THE ZONING BYLAW.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw 4-2001 is amended as hereinafter set forth:

a) Part IV – Zoning Districts

i. By deleting Section B. 6. of Schedule C: ICR – Intensive Country Residential District and inserting the following in its place

“6. Floor Area:

Detached accessory buildings: Maximum cumulative floor area of all detached accessory buildings – 111.5 m² (1,200 ft²) or the cumulative total developed residence floor area, whichever is greater.”

ii. By deleting Section B. 6. of Schedule D: MCR – Medium Country Residential District and inserting the following in its place

“6. Floor Area:

Detached accessory buildings: Maximum cumulative floor area of all detached accessory buildings – 111.5 m² (1,200 ft²) or the cumulative total developed residence floor area, whichever is greater.”

b) Part V – Definitions

i. By adding the following items:

“Abattoir: Shall mean a building or structure licensed by the Federal and/or Provincial Government specifically designated to accommodate the penning and slaughtering of live animals and the processing of animal carcasses that may include but is not limited to the packing, treating, storing and sale of the product on the premises.

“Soil Farm: Shall mean a site used for treating petroleum contaminated soils by reducing concentrations of petroleum constituents using above-ground biodegradation.”

2. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of the final approval of the Minister of Municipal Government.
