A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLUCHER, NO. 343 TO COMPEL THE REMOVAL OF DIRT, STONES, FILTH, RUBBISH OR SNOW FROM PUBLIC PLACES AND THE SECURING OF TRANSPORTED MATERIAL.

Pursuant to section 8 of *The Municipalities Act* The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any dirt, stones, filth, rubbish or any other encumbrance on any road, road allowance, land acquired for the widening of or diversion from a road allowance, lane or other public place within the municipality.
- 2) Any person depositing any dirt, stones, filth, rubbish or any other encumbrance on any road, road allowance, land acquired for the widening of or diversion from a road allowance, lane or other public place within the municipality shall remove the same and place it where directed by the council within twenty-four hours after being ordered to do so by the council.
- 3) No person shall operate a vehicle, including any trailer, on any right of way within the RM of Blucher No. 343 loaded with material unless the material is secured to prevent it from falling out of the vehicle by completely enclosing the material inside the vehicle or being secured by covering tarpaulin or similar covering or by fastening with ropes or cords or similar devices.
- 4) The Owner and/or operator of any vehicle or the person violating any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.00, provided that a violator of this bylaw, upon being served with a notice of violation, may at the Municipal Office and during municipal office hours, pay a voluntary reduced penalty of \$50.00 within 14 days of receiving a notice of violation and may, upon payment so provided, thereby avoid prosecution under this bylaw.
- 5) The Notice of violation shall be in Form 'A' as attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.
- 6) Bylaw No. 10-85 enacted on the 9th day of December, 1985, is hereby repealed.
