SARM Resolution Dedicated Lands 29-2018 - Boehm

That the following resolution be forwarded to SARM for consideration at their March, 2018 Annual SARM Convention:

"WHEREAS: The Dedicated Lands Regulations, 2009, requires that monies collected in lieu of dedicated lands during the subdivision process may only be used for the purchasing of dedicated lands, developing or upgrading public parks or public recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS the requirements of *The Planning and Development Act*, 2007 and *The Dedicated Land Regulations*, 2009 are biased towards urban municipalities as many RM's do not have or want to develop public parks or recreational facilities for various reasons, and the legislation does not provide alternative options; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Government Relations suggests that RM's donate money in lieu to urban municipalities within close proximity, however, most RM's feel that monies collected could be better utilized for infrastructure projects or projects that serve to benefit the public (ie. Fire services, water and waste treatment facilities) or are within close proximity to large urban centres that do not need funds from surrounding RM's;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that SARM lobby the Provincial Government, specifically the Ministry of Government Relations, to discuss these matters and to make changes to *The Dedicated Lands Regulations*, 2009 that will allow rural municipalities additional flexibility to use monies collected in lieu of dedicated lands for municipal infrastructure projects and fire services. Thereby correcting the current urban bias contained within legislation."
