

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, “firearm” means a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows, or any other thing.
2. Subject to sections 3 and 4 hereof, no person shall discharge any firearms within the limits of the Rural Municipality of Blucher No. 343, in the Province of Saskatchewan.
3. This bylaw shall not apply where a firearm is discharged:
 - a) by any person on land on which he is the actual occupant; or
 - b) by any person on land with the consent of the occupant of such land; or
 - c) by any person permitted to hunt under the Migratory Birds Convention Act (Canada) or the regulations thereunder; or
 - d) during the open season where the person is the holder of a license to hunt big game or game birds issued to him under The Wildlife Act; or
 - e) by any duly appointed Enforcement Officer of the Municipality.
4. The Administrator of the municipality, is hereby authorized to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit, in writing, entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities in the municipality.
5. No such club or organization as set out in section 4 hereof, shall operate at any time without such a permit, and the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit when requested to do so by any duly appointed enforcement officer, license inspector, or other authorized person.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
7. Bylaw Number 2-76 adopted on the 1st day of March, A.D. 1976, is hereby repealed.
