A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLUCHER, NO. 343 TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENCING OF OCCUPANTS OF MOBILE HOMES AND PORTABLE SHACKS THAT ARE NOT SITUATED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF A MOBILE HOME PARK FROM THE TIME OF ENTRY TO DECEMBER 31 OF THAT YEAR

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, No. 343, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Every occupant of a trailer, mobile home or portable shack used for residential purposes, within the confines of this municipality, and not situated within the confines of any mobile home park, shall within five days after expiration of thirty days from the date of entry into the municipality, register such trailer, mobile home or portable shack with the administrator of the municipality and pay a monthly licence for the balance of the current year.
- 2. The schedule of fees for a licence shall be based on the floor area of the trailer, mobile home or portable shack, based on outside dimensions and shall be as set out below and shall be paid one month in advance:

- 3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be subject to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
- 4. Bylaw No. 1-89 is hereby repealed.
