





Bylaw 10-2004

A building permit from the RM office is required before any new building is started or any building is structurally altered, moved or torn down. A development permit may be required before you can get a building permit. Note: if you do not obtain the necessary building and sewage disposal permit, you may be prosecuted and may have to remove the building.

Recycle used oil and oil filters at the North site only. Bring your own pump to transfer large quantities of used oil.

#### South site:

SW 14-34-01 W3 ½ mile North of the Town of Allan HOURS: Tuesday & Saturday 11 am – 4 pm (Run by the Town of Allan 306-257-3272)

Due to environmental regulations, the following items are **NOT PERMITTED in** the Waste Transfer Bin:

- Hazardous waste including paint, solvents, etc.
- Construction or demolition materials, tires
- Liquids of any kind
- Animals or animal parts
- Automotive parts, batteries, etc.
- Sod, dirt or concrete
- Tree clippings over 2' long
- Oil, oil filters, antifreeze, etc.

Separate newsprint, cardboard and tin cans and place them in the proper recycling bins.

Bylaw 4-2012: Loads must be properly secured including loads of trash/recycling, subject to a fine.

To be clear, if the control of noxious weeds is not done voluntarily, the RM will do the work and invoice the cost pursuant to The Noxious Weeds Act, and the landowner may also be charged with an offense.

## KNOW YOUR LAND LOCATION

before you call.

The 911 dispatcher will require your type of emergency and <u>your exact location</u>.

Your Legal Land Description (LLD) is on your Tax Notice. Your LLD looks like:

"NW 02-35-02 W3" NOTE – there are NO civic addresses in the RM.

FIRES: PLEASE NOTE YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR EVERY CALL OUT BY ANY FIRE DEPARTMENT.

The call out rates range from \$600 to \$900 per hour. With this in mind, we suggest you review your insurance policy to ensure you carry sufficient firefighting coverage. WE RECOMMEND A COVERAGE of \$20,000 to \$25,000.
